

Non-Compliant Materials

Advanced Disposal will not pick up any limbs that are longer than 4 ft, larger than 6-inches in diameter, or greater than 40 lbs. They will not pick up more than 4 cubic yards per residence. Small yard waste such as leaves and grass that is not bagged will not be picked up.



Non-compliant materials also include any materials that are considered construction debris including but not limited to: carpet, lumber, ply-wood, roofing materials, drywall, cabinets, sinks, toilets, etc.



Non-compliant trash next to our road ways presents possible safety hazards. Having these materials next to the road is a violation of Peach County Littering Ordinance.

Trash Service and Fees:

Peach County contracts with Advance Disposal, Inc. to pick-up household trash, yard waste and bulk waste. The trash fee is outlined on the yearly property tax bill and the cost is set by the Board of Commissioners. Owners of properties that are vacant may appeal the fee. Contact the Peach County Tax Commissioner’s office for more information on the appeal process (478.825.3161). Trash collection service may be started or reinstated by contacting the Public Works Department (478.825.8717).

Trash Collection Policies:

Trash collection policies are defined within the contract with Advance Disposal, Inc. Below is an outline of the policies:

Household Trash: Household trash collection service is performed Monday through Friday. Each resident will have their normal trash picked up once a week. The day on which this occurs varies based on the location of the property. In order to ensure the trash is collected, all residents should have their containers placed by the curb no later than 6:00 am. on the day of their scheduled pick-up. Containers should be placed within 2-ft. of the road edge, with the wheels facing toward the house on the opposite side of the driveway from the mailbox, and at least 4-ft. from poles, lamp posts, vehicles, or other obstructions.

Yard Waste/Bulk Item Service:

Once a month pick up of yard waste and debris is performed. The day of the yard waste pick-up service is based on resident’s scheduled weekly trash collection day. Please refer to the chart below for the yard waste pick-up schedule.

One bulk waste item may also be picked up once monthly on the scheduled yard waste pick-up day. Yard debris and bulk items must be piled next to the driveway before 6:00 am. on the scheduled pickup day.

Please refrain from placing any yard waste or bulk items in a drainage ditch. Placing anything other than stormwater in a drainage ditch is in violation of Georgia State law and the Federal Clean Water Act.

Yard Waste Collection Policies:

Yard Waste: The amount of yard waste can not exceed a total of 4 cubic yards per month per residence. All small yard waste such as leaves and grass must be placed in plastic bags prior to pick-up. Larger yard waste such as tree limbs must not exceed 4 ft. long, 6 inches in diameter, or 40 lbs.

Bulk Items: Only one bulk item will be picked up per month from each residence. These items include large waste items such as stoves, washing machines, mattresses and furniture but not waste that is classified as construction material.
