OFFICIAL SPECIAL ELECTION BALLOT OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA NOVEMBER 5, 2019

If you desire to vote YES or NO for a PROPOSED QUESTION, blacken the corresponding Oval (●). Use only blue or black pen or pencil.

Do not vote for more candidates than the number allowed for each specific office. Do not cross out or erase. If you erase or make other marks on the ballot or tear the ballot, your vote may not count.

If you change your mind or make a mistake, you may return the ballot by writing "Spoiled" across the face of the ballot and return envelope. You may then mail the spoiled ballot back to your county board of registrars, and you will be issued another official absentee ballot. Alternatively, you may surrender the ballot to the poll manager of an early voting site within your county or the precinct to which you are assigned. You will then be permitted to vote a regular ballot.

"I understand that the offer or acceptance of money or any other object of value to vote for any particular candidate, list of candidates, issue, or list of issues included in this election constitutes an act of voter fraud and is a felony under Georgia law." (OCGA 21-2-285(h) and 21-2-383(a))

Peach County 1 Percent Sales and Use Tax (Vote for One)

Shall a special one percent sales and use tax be imposed in the special district of Peach County for a period of time not to exceed six (6) years and for the raising of an estimated amount of \$21,774,600 for the purpose of funding the following capital outlay projects:

(A) Peach County Projects: Road, Street, and Bridge purposes including Paving and Drainage; County Buildings including Facilities, Equipment and Renovation to Spruce Street Complex; Recreation Park Improvements; Public Safety Equipment; Animal Control Facility and Equipment.

(B) Municipal Projects - City of Fort Valley: Street Projects; Public Works Equipment; Construction, Renovation and/or Upgrade to Public Buildings; Public Safety Vehicles and Equipment.

(C) Municipal Projects - City of Byron: Roads, Streets & Drainage purposes, Government Buildings and Equipment; Water & Sewer System Improvements, Cultural, Historical & Recreational purposes; Public Safety Facilities and Equipment.

Peach County School District General Obligation Bonds and 1% Sales and Use Tax for Educational Purposes (Vote for One)

Shall a total of \$14,000,000 in aggregate principal amount of Peach County School District general obligation debt (the "Bonds") be issued for the purpose of providing funds to pay for all or a portion of the costs of (i) (a) acquiring, constructing, and equipping a new Peach County High School to include athletic facilities; and (b) improving, repairing, and equipping existing buildings and facilities to include athletic facilities, acquiring technology, safety and security equipment, acquiring buses, purchasing vocational, fine arts and athletic equipment, and purchasing textbooks and e-books (collectively, the "Projects"); (ii) capitalized interest on the Bonds; and (iii) issuing the Bonds; and shall the special one percent sales and use tax for education currently in effect in Peach County be continued for a period of time not to exceed 20 calendar quarters and for the raising of not more than \$25,000,000 for the purposes of (a) the payment of principal and interest on the School District's previously incurred Peach County School District (Georgia) General Obligation Bonds, Series 2019 in a maximum amount of \$18,000,000; (b) the payment of a portion of the principal of and interest on the Bonds in the maximum amount of \$2,500,000; and (c) paying a portion of the costs of the Projects?
