

## Peach County BlastBall Rules

- 1). Practices/Sessions will be 50 Minutes. At the end of 50 minutes the batter in progress will be declared the last batter and the session will end.
- 2). Each batter will get only one tee adjustment and 3 swings to hit the ball fair or declared out. If the third swing is a foul, that batter will get one more swing. When the players hit the ball fair (between Blast base, Fair distance line marker and cone) they will run to the blast base.
- 3). The fielders try to catch the ball and holds ball up and yells "BLAST". If the field yells "BLAST" before the runner reaches the Blast Base, then the batter/runner is declared out. If batter/runner reaches the Blast base before fielder can yell "BLAST", the batter/runner is safe. The batter/runner will return to the dugout area once the play is over.
- 4). Every player bats every inning and the inning is not complete until every player has been at bat. Batting orders will be reversed each new inning at bat.
- 5). No player shall play catcher. One coach required to supervise the batting tee at all times. One coach allowed in the field behind the defending team. One coach required in the dugout area to supervise batting order and children.
- 6). Batter must make complete swing. No practice swings. If the batter obviously hits the tee and not the ball or completely misses it on the third swing the batter is out.
- 7). Defensive team must be a least 6 feet (2 adult steps) behind the fair distance line marker.
- 8). Head Coach serves as umpire. Score is NOT kept.
- 9). Each team will have a Head Coach and three assistant coaches.
- 10.) No baseball gloves allowed.
- 11). The base path is 25 feet and the fair distance line is 15 feet.
- 12). The head coach is responsible for pickup and return of BlastBall equipment from/to Park Supervisor.
